 Jobard makes incredibly pure wines with great length & concentration.

 Elegant oak-cask aged Chardonnay with rich flavours of ripe apple, lemon and tropical fruits with a hint of vanilla. It's a well rounded and elegant white wine with a complex nose dominated by exotic aromas. This Puligny Montrachet is extremely well balanced with a long lasting finish

## ROSE WINES

192. **2009 Valdivieso Cabernet Rose – Chile** **26.50**  
 This terrific cherry-red rose, overflowing with lots of ripe, sweet, grassy, blackcurranty fruit, made by a Kiwi winemaker, is a punchy, 13.5 per cent spring-into-summer delight.
193. **2009 Sancerre Rose La Cote Blanche Eric Louis – Loire** **38.50**  
 A lovely salmony pink colour, clear and bright with raspberries and strawberries bursting through on the nose and the palate. Dry soft and subtle with an elegant finish.

210. **2009 Villa dei Fiori Montepulciano d'Abruzzo – Italy** **24.00**  
 Ripe, rounded Italian red that combines slightly rustic, spicy black olive and morello cherry notes with smooth, juicy tannins and bright, refreshing acidity.
211. **2009 Pinot Noir Vin de Pays, Bouchard Aine and Fils – South of France** **26.00**  
 Bursting with primary red fruits and soft smooth tannins.

212. **2009 Beaujolais Villages, Mommessin– Beaujolais** 32.00  
A single vineyard Beaujolais combining a bold up-front fruit character of Gamay with height and sense terroir.
213. **2009 Brouilly Les Grumieres Mommessin – Beaujolais** 36.00  
Soft, juicy red with bags of strawberry, red cherry and blackberry fruit flavours, crisp acidity and just a whisper of supporting tannin.
214. **2009 Fleurie Millesime Cave de Fleurie - Beaujolais** 36.50  
A striking and vivid red colour, with several punnets worth of red berry fruit on the nose and palate. Soft and fresh with light, ripe tannins and crisp acidity it is a benchmark Beaujolais
215. **2008/09 Chateau De L'Hospitalet Pinot noir, Gerard Bertrand – Burgundy** 38.50  
This Pinot noir from the cool foothills of the Pryenees is very refined, silky and smooth from beginning to end. It has notes of dry spice and subtle raspberry fruit. Soft, elegant and delicious.

A vibrant wine with juicy plum and blackberry characters. The fruit intensity is carried on to the palate with soft tannins & ripe, sweet fruit. Hints of vanilla provide a silky elegance to the finish.

Delicious, soft claret with restrained, elegant blackcurrant and plum fruit on both nose and palate backed up by savoury, juicy tannins and fresh acidity.

Lovingly nurtured vines reward Agustin Cetto with splendid, well balanced wines. A dark wine with blackcurrant flavours and a good finish.
234. **2009 Agustinos Carmenere - Chile** 32.00  
A medium bodied well balanced wine with a smooth finish. Red fruits, plums and blackberries on the palate accompanied with hints of black pepper.
235. **2008 Madfish Cabernet Merlot Margaret River – Western Australia** 38.00  
Meaty and evolving. Smooth and rich, with powerful dark fruit. Spicy and warm finish.

270. **2008/09 Cote du Rhone Rouge, Louis Bernard – Rhone** 30.00  
Soft juicy Cotes du Rhone with classic strawberry Grenache fruit matched with Syrah's peppery spice.
271. **2008 Malbec Reserva, Terrazas de los Andes, Mendoza – Argentina** 38.00  
From one of Argentina's finest estate vineyards, a stunning wine, laden with great complexity.
272. **2006/08 Crozes Hermitage Louis Bernard - Rhone** 36.00  
Flavours of ripe red fruits, blackcurrants and liquorice run through the body of the wine. Aromas of leather, and roasted coffee are accompanied by hints of red pepper and truffle.
273. **2006 Château de Lugagnac,– Bordeaux** 40.00  
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and a small amount of Petit Verdot forms this great Bordeaux which has a complex character and elegant flavours on the palate, accompanied with aromas of red and black fruits.
274. **2004 Rioja Reserva, Castillo de Clavijo – Spain** 42.00  
Bodegas Criadores are renowned for making classic style wines and this rich, full-bodied Reserva is certainly no exception.
275. **2007 Nuits St George, Roche de Bellene, Vieilles Vignes - Burgundy** 76.00  
Complex red fruits on the nose. Smooth, with well integrated tannins and deep plummy flavours. Drinking wonderfully now.
276. **Valdivieso Caballo Loco 'Number 11' NV – Chile** 60.00  
A complex profile of ripe berry fruits, sweet spices, nutmeg, cinnamon & vanilla. A full-bodied wine, with structure and length, balancing well the powerful fruit & spice flavours. Very ripe in style.
277. **2006/07 Chateau Gruard Larose, St Julien– Bordeaux** 65.50  
Luscious cassis aromas give way to dusty cedar notes of Indian spice. There is an upfront sweetness to the palate with a deep core of black fruit guided by tannins. Good acidity, tannin and freshness leave an elegant aging wine.
278. **2007 Les Charmes Gevrey Chambertin, Vieilles Vignes Nicolas Potel** 78.00  
This wine, made with sixty year old Pinot Noir vines, has a deep bright colour with black flashes. On the palate it is very fruity with a pleasant woody aroma and soft tannins.
279. **2006 Barolo Zonchera Ceretto – Italy** 85.00  
Soft, velvety Barolo, with fewer tannins than many of its peers. Well-balanced and ripe with savoury cherry and blackberry fruit and a savoury, leathery edge on the long finish.
280. **2005 Villa Banfi Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany – Italy** 88.00  
Brunello is unquestionably one of Italy's, if not one of Europe's great wines and Villa Banfi are really at the cutting edge of winemaking in this region. The beautiful Tuscan town of Montalcino sits high on a hill, perfect vantage to admire immaculate vineyards below. Dark, rich and concentrated this vintage is opening up beautifully and drinking.
